EPIPHANY

We now enter the Season of Epiphany. Epiphany is January 6th and is the time we celebrate the arrival of the Maji arriving in Bethlehem to worship Jesus. This event reminds us that the glory of the Lord, revealed in Jesus, is for all nations and people.

In the seasonal time after Epiphany, we see Jesus revealed in his ministry from the time of his baptism to the Transfiguration. The gospel stories of this season describe various events that manifest the divinity of Jesus including the wedding at Cana, the calling of the disciples, and various miracles and teachings of Jesus. The Last Sunday after the Epiphany is always devoted to the Transfiguration. Jesus' identity as the Son of God is dramatically revealed in the Transfiguration gospel, as well as the gospel of the baptism of Christ.
